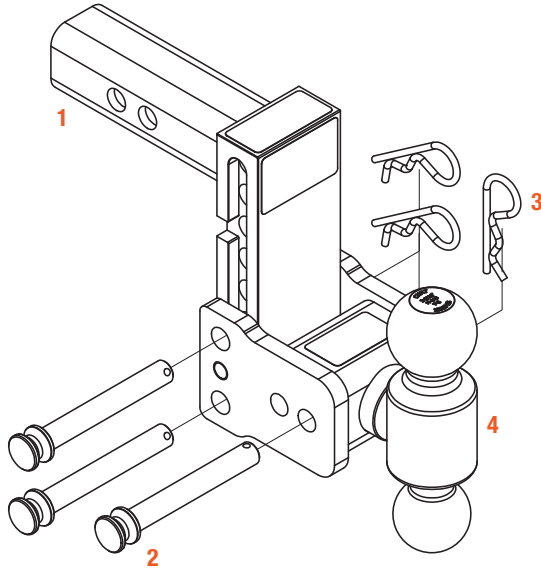

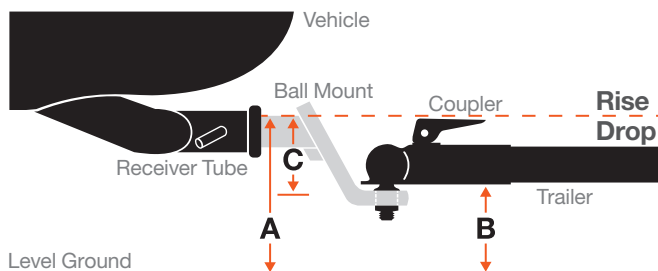
Step 1 - Insert into the Trailer Hitch

Begin by installing the shank (#1) into the trailer hitch receiver and secure it with a hitch pin and clip (sold separately).

Step 2 - Determine Required Ball Height

Determine the proper ball height by leveling the trailer and measuring from the bottom of the trailer tongue to the ground, see below.

Find the hole closest to that measurement on the adjustable shank (#1). The trailer ball platform (#4) will be centered on that hole.



Step 3

Based on the determined ball height, remove the two adjustment pins and clips and align with the proper hole locations. Reinstall the pins and clips to set the new height.

Step 4

Store: Remove the dual ball pin and clip and rotate the dual ball 90 degrees to store the dual ball. Remove the two adjustment pins and clips, guide the dual ball mount down the adjustment groove and rotate the dual ball mount to the backside of the adjustable shank. Reinstall pins to secure dual ball mount.

Tow: Remove the two adjustment pins and clips, guide the dual ball mount down the adjustment groove and rotate the dual ball mount to the front side of the adjustable shank. Reinstall pins to secure dual ball mount at the desired ball height. Remove the dual ball pin and clip and rotate the dual ball 90 degrees to the tow position.
